



2010 - MIAA Football Officiating Camps

Football Officials,

The MIAA Conference will have two football officiating camps in the spring of 2010. The two camps we had last year not only helped improve our staff they also helped the Heart of America, JUCO, & KCAC staffs. Also the camps helped generate a lot of interest in college football officiating. My goal now is to have a staff of (Seven or Eight Crews) three or four swing officials, a small list of preferred guests invited to our clinic, as well as a list of officials that are ready to move to the MIAA. Both camps will be informative, educational, with an emphasis on training and helping each official reach their potential. We wanted to have two camps so you would have a choice of dates to attend, as everyone seems to be very busy in the springtime.

The first camp will be held at Northwest Missouri State University – Maryville, Missouri - Friday, Saturday, Sunday, April – 9, 10, 11.

The second camp will be held at Pittsburg State University Pittsburg, Kansas - Friday, Saturday, Sunday, April 23, 24, 25

What will each camp have?

Each camp is open to all officials wanting to move to the College level, High School officials wanting to learn more about officiating or officials that are already working College football and want to improve their skills. The Northwest camp will have a spring game on Sunday afternoon (will select two crews to work the spring game) the remainder of the camp will be classroom & on field mechanics. The Pittsburg camp will have more on field scrimmages at Pittsburg & Southern. The registration fee for each camp, which includes a Notebook, T-shirt, Four Meals, Drinks and Snacks during breaks and Drinks and Snacks at the socials, will be \$200. If you spend the night Friday, or Saturday, the official is responsible for their own lodging. We will have a list of hotels and the discount price for our campers.

Who will be the Instructors?

Phil Laurie, supervisor of officials for the MIAA will lead each camp. We will have several Big 12 officials as well as several MIAA officials helping at each camp. We will have at least two instructors for each position. We will also have a guest speaker at each camp. (NFL)

Hotels?

When we make the final list of campers going to each camp we will then make a rooming list and assign the room numbers. You may pick a roommate when the list is sent to you around February, 19th. You do not have to stay at one of the hotels, if you want to drive in each day or stay with friends that would be OK.

Registrations?

As registrations are received, officials will be assigned a position and a crew to work with. We will assign you to a position that you select on your registration.
